Lung cancer is the most commonly diagnosed cancer among West Virginia residents. **The Lung Cancer Screening Program at CAMC** allows our patients a chance to detect lung cancer earlier, when it is most treatable, and possibly even curable.

You may be eligible for the low-cost screening program if you:

Are between the ages of 50 and 77, not showing any signs or symptoms of lung cancer, and have a smoking history equivalent to:

- Smoking one pack per day or more for 20 years
- Current or ex-smoker who has quit within the last 15 years

A physician's order is required for screening. Patients who meet the screening criteria will receive a low-dose radiation CT, and results will be provided to the patient's ordering physician. Consult your physician to discuss eligibility requirements.
